The Mather High School Alumni Fund plans for the next school year!

As reported in past newsletters, the 2009-10 school year has been very exciting for our alumni association. Our successes include:

- Awarded \$10,000 in scholarships to five deserving seniors
- Expanded alumni involvement in on-going volunteer activities
- Increased communications with Mather administration and staff about alumni activities via teacher-only web page and e-bursts
- Elected a new Board of Directors
- Hired new staff to coordinator the volunteer program
- Connected with over 66% of the student body through alumni activities

We are currently setting goals for the 2010-11 school year. These include:

• Award a minimum of one full scholarship and 4 special awards, totaling \$10,000

- Increase alumni volunteer hours by 15%
- Expand and add new activities that introduce Mather students in all grades to post-secondary college and career choices
- Coordinate events to highlight the new library at Mather

The 2009-10 school year has been very successful for our volunteer program!

Throughout the year alumni volunteered to:

Career Goals of the Mather Freshman Class

A recent survey (March, 2010) of the freshman class at Mather revealed the career aspirations of these young people. Of the 208 respondents, 29% are interested in Business and 32% were interested in the Medical-Health Science field. Not surprisingly, 38% showed an interest in Law Enforcement and the Legal Profession, since Mather has a selective Law Academy Program which attracts many serious students with these interests. Students were asked to indicate which of 22 career areas were of interest to them. 58% focused on 1-3 areas, indicating that many of these 14 year olds had already narrowed their focus.

There were distinct gender differences. 41% of the boys indicated an interest in Business (only 21% girls), whereas 43% of the girls chose the Medical Field (15% boys). In areas such as Social Work, 23% of the girls and only 8% of the boys indicated interest. Both boys and girls indicated a strong interest in Fine Arts/Film and the Music Industry, and the boys

indicated a very strong interest in the Sports Industry, perhaps all indicative of their interests, rather than serious career aspirations.

The Computer Industry, the Military and the Hospitality Industries also garnered notable interest. Some students indicated more specific career goals such as digital photographers, chefs, game designers, and fashion designers.

43% of the students indicated that they don't know anyone in their fields of interest. Our Alumni Speakers Bureau and the Sandi Port Errant Volunteer Program offers an opportunity for alumni to get involved in the career development of these young people.
